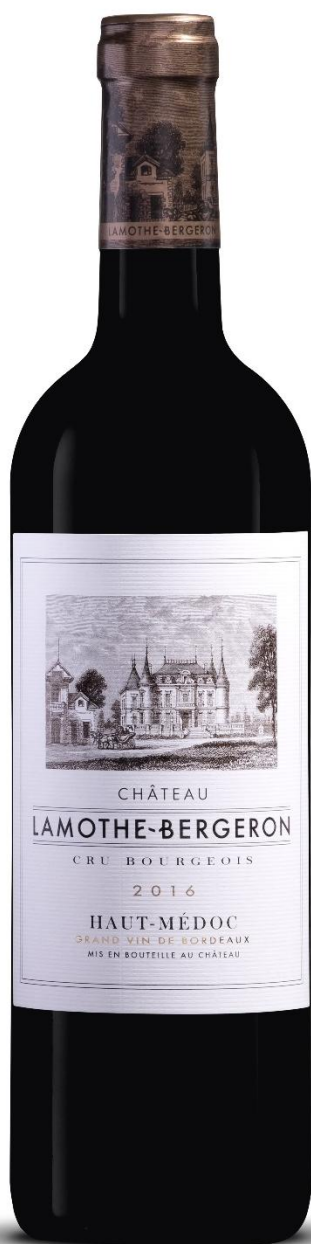

TASTING

Our 2016 vintage has a good concentration of tannins, high anthocyanins, very intense colours with a nose of black fruits, a structured mouth with roundness, suggesting a great vintage.

BLEND OF THE VINTAGE

50 % Cabernet Sauvignon, 45 % Merlot, 5% Petit Verdot

54 hl/ha
