*Deep, dense, tinged with purple glints.  
Nose tight enough. The aromatic bouquet,  
with fruity and spicy notes, is complex.  
Some aromas of black berries.  
In the mouth, the attack is rich, intense,  
lively.  
The wine offers a nice length.  
It is hot, solar, spicy. The aftertaste is done  
on black fruits and fresh fruits.  
The grain is fine, the tannins are silky.  
It has an aromatic wine, supple,  
seductive with some woody notes.*
